



PINOT GRIS 2022

Freedom of the Press

Freedom of the Press is an exciting new urban winery located on a hill above Minster Lovell in the Cotswolds, 15 miles from Oxford. Sourcing the very best grapes from Essex, and specifically vineyards at Martin's Lane in the Crouch Valley, and Bromley Brook, near Colchester, the juice is turned into wine on a beautiful farm in the Cotswolds.

Destemmed, not crushed, gravity-fed to press, whole berry pressed, 'champagne' cycle. 20% fermented in 3-year-old 500l oak from tonellerie Radoux (ex Burgundy) and 80% in a 17HL Nomblot concrete egg. Matured for 12 months in a combination of concrete egg and old (5 or 6 yr) oak barrels, on part lees, with occasional pump-over.

The Pinot Gris that Gavin Carver has produced is clean and fresh with notes of citrus and meadow, and a linear minerality running through.
